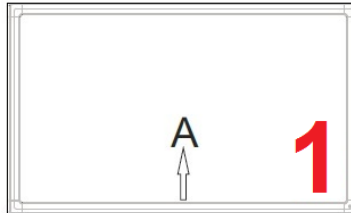

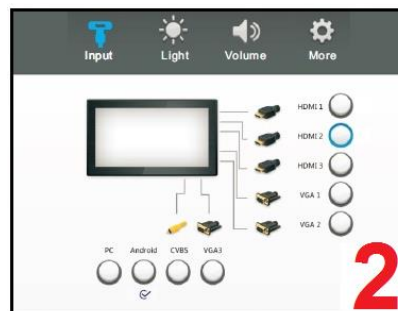


## **Specktron Android Simple Touch (White Board) User Guide**

1. Press the PC power button (backside Specktron monitor) to enter standby when power is on;  
Click the power button (Front side Specktron monitor) to switch on.
2. Take a middle point position on the bottom of the Specktron display screen as starting point,  
Use a touch pen/ finger to drag towards screen center position to call up touch menu. **(Pic 1)**



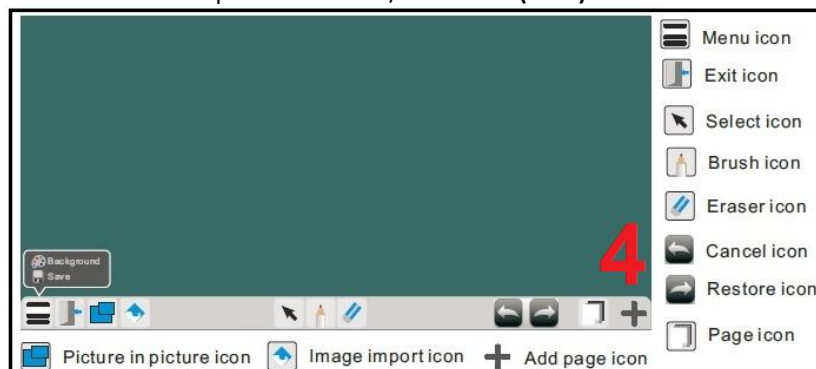
3. Select media as **Andriod**.  This symbol represents that this channel has been connected to a signal. **(Pic 2)**



4. Switch to Android channel to display main interface shown as below. Select **"Simple Touch"** icon for the white board. **(Pic 3)**



5. Below screen shot detail about Simple Touch menu/tools icon. **(Pic 4)**



6. Annotation menu is supporting easily Screenshot & Highlite documents/pic, Short cut, etc.. **( Pic 5)**  
Place **two fingers** on the screen and stay more than two seconds under any channel to call up annotation **(Fig:1)**.  
In annotation menu is shown in **(Fig : 2)**.

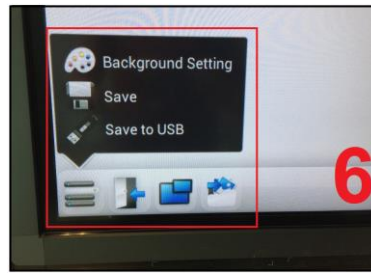
**Note:** Annotation highlight will not save in Simple Touch white board and your documents





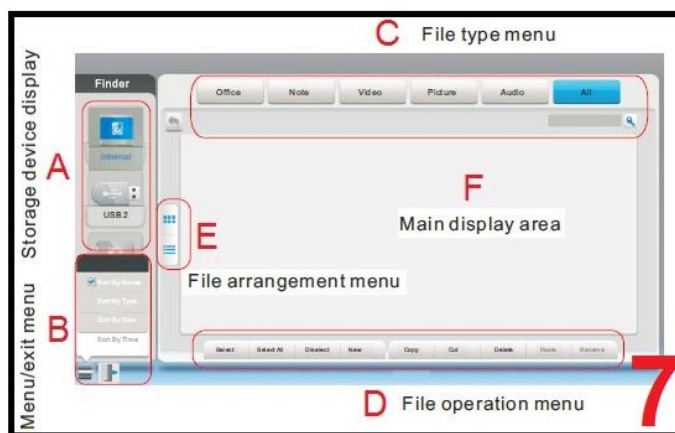

7. Two options for saving your documents in simple touch software. (1. Save to Internal Storage 2. Save to USB). (Pic 6)



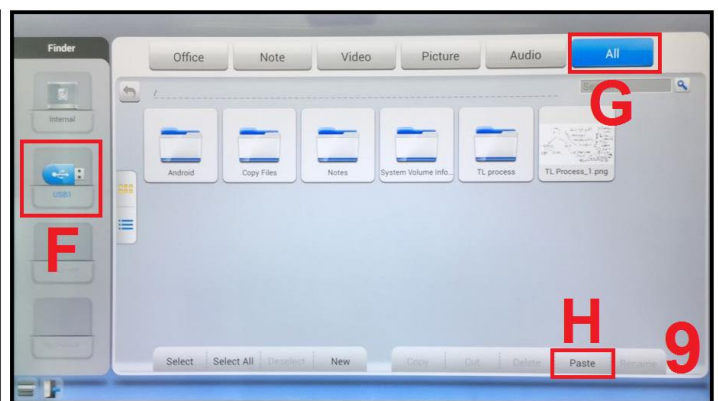
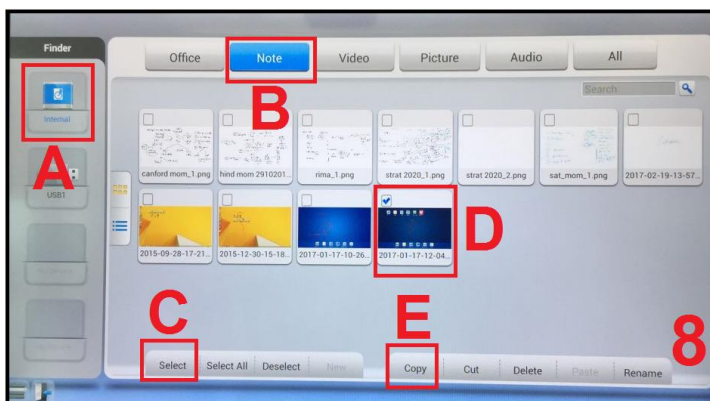
8. Saved or screen shot documents will be placed in **"Finder"** storage area (Notes or All file type menu). (Pic 7)  
For viewing **"Finder"** storage switch to display main interface

**Note:** Simple Touch saves only "png" format.



9. For moving documents from Finder Internal Storage to USB find below screen shot (make sure USB connected in Android USB port).

- A : Select **"Internal Storage"** in finder
- B : Click **"Note"** button to find saved documents
- C : Click **"Select"** button for picking moving documents
- D : Select saved documents
- E : Click **"Copy/Cut"**
- F : Select **"USB"** connected in android UDB port
- G : Click **"All"** file type menu for viewing USB storage area
- H : Click **"Paste"** button for saving documents in USB
